


HOLIDAY LIGHT & MUSIC SHOW WITH REMOTE

ADD DETERMINED WATTS FOR EACH PLUGGED-IN APPLIANCE OR LAMP (SUM OF WATTS ON BULBS) TO FIND TOTAL WATTS BEING USED.

- ONLY USE THE BATTERIES SPECIFIED AND BE SURE TO MATCH THE + AND POLARITY MARKINGS.
- REMOVE EXHAUSTED OR DEAD BATTERIES FROM THE PRODUCT.
- REMOVE BATTERIES IF PRODUCT IS NOT TO BE USED FOR A LONG TIME.

THIS ITEM IS A RADIO FREQUENCY DEVICE (RF), AND AS SUCH THE RANGE OF THE REMOTE CONTROL IS DEPENDENT ON MANY FACTORS. ACTUAL OPERATIONAL DISTANCE WILL VARY BASED ON WALLS AND LINE OF SIGHT OBSTRUCTIONS, AND OTHER NEARBY ELECTRONIC DEVICES.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Insert the receiver base's 3-prong plug into a grounded outlet.
- 2. Plug light sets into the 3 outlets on the receiver base. Do not plug more than 250W of lights into any one outlet of the receiver base. If watts are not marked on your light string, multiply the ampere rating by 125 to determine equivalent watts.
- 3. Using the snowman ornament transmitter, press the corresponding button to activate the desired light and music effects.
- 4. Excessive switching between effects may cause the receiver to stop responding. If this occurs, simply turn off the remote to reset its internal computer chip, wait a few moments, and then turn the unit back on.
- 5. Volume control is on the left side of the receiver base.

FEATURES EXPLAINED

MUSIC F/X	Attached light sets strobe to the music
NEXT SONG	Skip ahead to the next holiday tune
CHASE	3 attached light strings turn on and off in sequence to create a chasing effect
LIGHT SHOW	Light strings will perform multiple special effects, including fading, chasing, and flashing

BATTERY REPLACEMENT:

The snowman ornament transmitter uses a 3V CR2032 battery, which is included. To replace the battery, slide off the battery cover on the back of the transmitter. Insert a new 3V CR2032 battery, making sure to match up to the + and - polarity markings. To test, press the ON and OFF buttons to make sure that the LED lights up. Slide the battery cover back on. Do not dispose of old batteries in fire. Batteries may explode or leak. Check with local regulations on the proper disposal of spent batteries.
